


STATE OF MINNESOTA



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The School of Agriculture, University of Minnesota, was established in 1888; and

WHEREAS: The graduating class of 1890 created the first alumni of the School of Agriculture; and

WHEREAS: Public spirited and energetic SAUM graduates conceived the idea that if all the alumni were banded together into an association to promote and further the interests of agriculture in Minnesota, the benefits to themselves, and to all others with whom they came into contact, would be wide-spread and of untold proportions; and

WHEREAS: The Association embodies an understanding and a perfecting of agricultural education and the development of nature studies and the cultivation of insight into, and affection for, nature as the greatest of revealers, teachers, and comforters; and

WHEREAS: SAUM from its inception has been a potent factor in the development of agricultural pursuits in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Among its membership are found some of the state's most progressive agriculturists, business and community leaders; and

WHEREAS: The Association now numbers 1,800 members living to enjoy this centennial celebration;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the fourth week of April to be
