The Star of the North State Games is Minnesota's largest annual amateur sports WHEREAS:

WHEREAS: The Star of the North State Games is a multi-sport event modeled after the Olympic

Games and open to all Minnesotans, regardless of age or skill level; and

More than 20,000 Minnesotans have participated in the Star of the North State Games since the Games were first held in 1988; and WHEREAS:

WHEREAS: The State Games movement is increasing in awareness nationally and is recognized by the

U.S. Olympic Committee as a growing grass-roots sports program; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota is one of 40 states nation-wide which will stage a State Games event for its

citizens in 1990; and

WHEREAS: The Star of the North State Games is a perfect model of state-wide cooperation, relying

on the support of parents, youth, major corporations, sport organizations, school systems, local and state government and civic organizations for the success of the

It is the goal of the Star of the North State Games Board to offer Minnesotans of any age or skill the opportunity to participate in the annual State Games; and WHEREAS:

WHEREAS: A state-wide campaign throughout the schools, health clubs, park and recreation groups,

corporate sponsors, volunteer organizations and media is necessary to insure that all Minnesotans are aware of the opportunities to participate in the 1990 Star of the North Games in Rochester from June 15-24; and

WHEREAS: Awareness for the State Games begins several month before the event occurs in the

summer and Minnesotans are encouraged to register early to take part in the event; and

Janet Karvonen and Darrell Thompson, two of Minnesota's great athletes, have been selected as honorary co-chairs for the 1990 Star of the North Games; WHEREAS:
