



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: The sport of tennis has grown in popularity throughout the State of Minnesota and has made important contributions to the quality of life in the state; and
- WHEREAS: The development of women's tennis programs in Minnesota has made the state a leader in both competitive and recreational tennis for women, as exemplified by the Northwest Women's Daytime League, the largest indoor recreational league of its kind in the United States; and
- WHEREAS: The efforts of the Women's Daytime League in collecting 1,000 racquets for use in schools and community programs typify the spirit of Minnesota and our tradition of contribution to the common good; and
- WHEREAS: The accomplishments of the Women's Daytime League will be celebrated on the occasion of the Women's Daytime League luncheon on May 8, 1990; and
- WHEREAS: In recognition of the leading position of the State in the promotion of women's tennis, the Women's 35/45 National Indoor Tennis Tournament will be held in Minneapolis during the period May 7-13, 1990;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 7-May 13, 1990 to be

WOMEN'S TENNIS WEEK

in Minnesota.
