WHEREAS: The land of Israel was the birthplace of the Jewish people and where their spiritual, religious and national identity was formed; and

WHEREAS: Since 1948, the miraculous return of the Jewish people to their homeland has been celebrated on the 5th day of the Hebrew month of Iyar, the date of the founding of the modern State of Israel; and

WHEREAS: The State of Israel is based on the foundations of liberty, justice and peace; and

WHEREAS: The State of Israel is prepared to contribute its share in a common effort for the advancement of the entire Middle East; and

WHEREAS: April 30, 1990 represents the 42nd anniversary of the founding of the modern State of Israel;
