ORDINANCE NO. 1990-184

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING APPROXIMATELY 18 ACRES OF LAND OWNED BY THE CITY IN SECTION 14 OF WAKEFIELD TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the City owns approximately 18.1 acres of land in Section 14 of Wakefield Township, which is currently being utilized by the City as the site of a municipal wastewater treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, such land abuts upon the corporate limits of the City of Cold Spring within the meaning of Minnesota Statutes Section 414.011, subd. 6; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Section 414.033, a municipal council may by ordinance declare land annexed to the municipality if the land is owned by the municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Cold Spring ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. The City of Cold Spring, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Section 414.033, subd. 2, hereby annexes the following described land, together with adjacent public road right-of-way easements, as follows:

All that part of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Fourteen (14), Township One Hundred Twenty-three (123) North, Range Thirty (30) West, lying South of the Sauk River, North of the Northwesterly right of way line of Burlington Northern Railway and Easterly of a line described as follows: Beginning at a point on the Northwesterly right of way line of the Burlington Northern Railway with a line 793.27 feet west of, measured at a right angle to and parallel with the east line of said Southwest Quarter and assuming said east line bears NORTH; thence North 02 degrees 47 minutes West 1025 feet, more or less, to the shoreline of the Sauk River and there terminating. EXCEPT the west 20.00 feet of the above described tract as recorded in Document Number 0621222 and recorded June 19, 1987, in the Office of the County Recorder, Stearns County, Minnesota. Said tract contains 18.1 acres more or less. TOGETHER with a 20 foot tract being a part of the Southeast Quarter of Southwest Quarter, Section Fourteen (14), Township One Hundred Twenty-three (123) North, Range Thirty (30) West, Stearns County, Minnesota, described as follows: From the intersection of the northwesterly right-of-way line of the Burlington Northern Railroad with a line of 793.27 feet west of, measured at a right angle to and parallel with

the east line of said Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter and assuming said east line bears NORTH; thence North 02 degrees 47 minutes 00 seconds West 224.33 feet; thence South 87 degrees 13 minutes 00 seconds West 60.11 feet; thence South 02 degrees 47 minutes 00 seconds East 245.58 feet to said northwesterly right-of-way line being the point of beginning; thence North 02 degrees 47 minutes 00 seconds West 245.58 feet; thence South 87 degrees 13 minutes 00 seconds West 20.00 feet; thence South 02 degrees 47 minutes 00 seconds East to said northwesterly right-of-way line; thence northeasterly on said right-of-way to the point of beginning. Said tract contains 0.1 acres more or less.

SECTION 2. The City Council of the City of Cold Spring hereby finds and determines that the above-described land in Section 14, Wakefield Township, is owned by the City of Cold Spring, abuts upon the present territorial limits of the City of Cold Spring, is conditioned as to be properly subject to municipal government, and such land is deemed to be urban or suburban in character or about to become so, and the annexation of said land will be in the best interests of the City of Cold Spring and the above-described land.

SECTION 3. The land described in Section 1 above and outlined in the map attached hereto and incorporated herein as "Exhibit A," is hereby annexed, added to, and made part of the City of Cold Spring, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage, publication, and approval by the Minnesota Municipal Board.

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
