An Unsurveyed Island located in the S.E. portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, and the N.E. portion of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township 117 North, Range 25 West, 5th P.M., lying on the Section line between said Sections and about 475 feet due East of the present N.E. point of government Lot 1 of Sec. 34-117-23, containing approximately 0.40 acre.

You are allowed thirty (30) days from the receipt of this notice, within which to file in said General Land Office, any papers you may wish to submit, tending to show cause, if any there be, why the said Island should not be surveyed and disposed of as public land of the United States.
