

Section 144-a CEMETARY APPROPRIATIONS

The City Council shall have power to appropriate from the General Fund of the City by resolution passed by two-thirds vote of all members of such council an amount not to exceed in the aggregate the sum of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00) in any one year, and authorize payment of the money so appropriated to such cemetery associations within the city of Virginia as operate and maintain cemeteries. All money so appropriated to be used for such purposes and under such regulations as the city council may specify.
