


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I,

by statute, and particularly by authority of section

constitute and appoint JAMES E.MARKHAM, of St.Paul,
Minnesota, to be deputy attorney general of the state

and ending the first Monday in January, 1931, unless
sooner removed.
