West, (N.W. 1/4 S.W. 1/4 - 13 - 161 - 42) contain-  
ing forty acres, more or less, according  
to government survey.

Section two.

This ordinance shall take effect and  
be in force from and after its publication  
and a certified copy thereof has been filed  
with the secretary of state.
