


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I,

tute and appoint JOHN F. BONNER of Minneapolis, Minne-  
sota, to be an assistant attorney general of the state

and ending the first Monday in January, 1931, unless  
sooner removed.
