Dear Sir:

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Commissioner of Game and Fish by the Laws of 1919, Chapter 400, Section 124, Subdivision 8, which subdivision has been added to Chapter 400 by Laws of 1925, Chapter 419, I have petitioned the Governor of the State of Minnesota, the Attorney General, the State Auditor and the Commissioner of Forestry and Fire Prevention, that certain lands lying within the confines of Koochiching County and certain lands and waters lying within the confines of. St. Louis County, be set aside and removed from sale or lease, including all timber thereon, and not subject to leases or permits heretofore made, for the purpose of establishing Public Hunting Grounds and Game Sanctuaries, and for the purpose of reforestation.

This petition was heard January 29th, 1929, and was approved by the Governor, the Attorney General, the State Auditor and the Commissioner of Forestry and Fire Prevention.

I am enclosing herewith a copy of such Order, duly signed, containing the legal descriptions of such lands and waters.

I, George W. Mc Cullough, as Commissioner of Game and Fish of the State of Minnesota, pursuant to the arthority in me vested by Laws 1919, Chapter 400, Section 124, Subd. 8, which subdivision is added to said Chapter 400 by Laws 1925, Chapter 419, do hereby select, set aside and reserve from lands owned by the state, and suitable for the purpose of establishing and reforesting large and small public hunting grounds, and game refuges, the lands hereinafter described, subject to existing rights under timber permits and leases heretofore issued or made, and do hereby establish thereon public hunting grounds:

## Public Hunting Grounds No. 1

The lands owned by the state within the following described area;

Commencing at a point where the Indian Reservation line intersects with the North line of Sec. 30, T. 155 No. R. 28 W., Koochiching County, running thence in a Northeasterly direction on said Indian Reservation Line until said line intersects with the Old Indian Reservation Line, so called, between Sections 28 and 33, T. 157, no. R. 27 W., thence northerly on said Old Indian Reservation Line until the same intersects with the Black River in Sec. 38, T. 158 No. R. 27 W., thence easterly along the Black River until the same intersects with the right-of-way of the Minnesota, Dakota and Western Railroad in Sec. 11, T. 158 No. R. 25 W., thence along the south side of said Railroad right-of-way easterly to its intersection with the Big Fork River in Sec. 6, T. 69 No. R. 27 W., Koochiching County, thence south along the Big Fork River until its intersection with the Sturgeon River in Sec. 29, T. 155 No. R. 25 W., Koochiching County, thence westerly along the Sturgeon River until its intersection with the North line of Sec. 29, T. 155 No. R. 28 W., thence west along said north line of said Sec. 29 and north line of Sec. 30. T. 155 No. R. 28 W., to place of beginning.

Game Refuges and Public Hunting Grounds No. 2

The following described lands are hereby designated as game refuges and public hunting grounds No. 2:
