
PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS the General Statutes of the State of Minnesota provide that the Friday preceding Easter Sunday, known as Good Friday, is a legal holiday and that no public business shall be transacted on such day except in case of necessity;


NOW THEREFORE, I, Theodore Christianson, Governor of Minnesota, proclaim that Friday, March 29th, 1929, may be observed by the citizenry of the State of Minnesota as such legal holiday.
