An Ordinance extending the boundaries of the Village of Cass Lake, Minnesota and including certain <sup>un-</sup>platted land.

The Village Council of the Village of Cass Lake, do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1 : The boundaries of the Village of Cass Lake, in the County of Cass, State of Minnesota, are hereby extended so as to include therein the following described lands, to wit: The Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section Ten (10) , Township One Hundred Forty Five (145) North of Range Thirty-One(31) West, except that part on which the Grade School of Independent School District No. Three (3) of Cass County is located, which is already a part of the Village of Cass Lake.

Sec. 11 : This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication and the filing of a certified copy hereof in the office of the Secretary of State.
