
EXTENDING ADDITIONAL PROTECTION TO MINNOWS IN DEER,

WHEREAS, it has been represented to the Game and  
Fish Commissioner that minnows are in danger of undue  
depletion in the waters of Deer, Fawn, Joe Gould, and  
Moose Lakes, Itasca County, State of Minnesota, and


WHEREAS, the Game and Fish Commissioner has  
investigated and has presented me with the results of  
his investigation, and has recommended that additional  
protection be given minnows in the above named lakes  
to prevent their undue depletion.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Theodore Christianson, Governor  
of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of and pursuant to  
authority vested in me by Section 134, Chapter 400, S.L.  
Minnesota, 1929, Sec. 5640, G.S. 1923, do hereby order  
that no minnows be taken from the Deer, Fawn, Joe Gould,  
and Moose Lakes, Itasca County, State of Minnesota, to  
be sold or bought and transported for commercial purposes  
during the seasons of 1929 and 1930.

This order shall remain in force until the close of  
the 1931 regular session of the legislature of the State  
of Minnesota unless sooner revoked or modified.
