THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that at a Village Election, held in the village of Baudette, in said County and State, on the 12 th. day of January, A.D.1907, the same being an election held for the purpose of electing Village Officers upon the organization of the village, notice of which has been duly posted and published according to law, the question was submitted to the qualified electors of said Village, of making and constituting the said village a separate assessment and election district. NOTICE OF THE FIRST VILLAGE  
ELECTION IN THE VILLAGE OF  
BAUDETTE, BELTRAMI COUNTY,  
MINNESOTA.

WHEREAS on November 13, 1906, a petition was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of said County, signed by fifty-two resident voters within the limits of the territory proposed to be incorporated as the Village of Baudette, a full and complete description of said territory being set forth in said petition, praying for the incorporation of a village to be named Baudette; and

WHEREAS said petition was granted by said Board of County Commissioners who ordered an election to be held within said territory on the 11th day of December, 1906 and also appointed inspectors to conduct the said election; and

WHEREAS said election was regularly held as by said Board ordered, a majority of the votes cast being in favor of incorporation of said village, all of which was duly certified by said inspectors to the County Auditor of said County and filed in his office on December 17, 1906, a certified copy of all of said incorporation papers being filed by the said County Auditor in the office of the Secretary of State on December 18, 1906.

Now THEREFORE notice is hereby given that on January 12, 1907, between the hours 1 o'clock P. M. and 7 o'clock P. M. on said day, the first village election for the election of village officers will be held, and at said election all persons within said territory who would be qualified to vote at the general elections will be entitled to vote.

The village officers to be elected are as follows, to-wit;

A Treasurer, a President, a Clerk, three Trustees, an Assessor, two Justices of the Peace, and two Constables.

FURTHER NOTICE is also hereby given that at said village election, the question of constituting and establishing said village as separate election and assessment district will be submitted to the electors of the village,

And to do and perform any other business proper to be done at said election.
