says the annexed printed copy of Notice of *Ordinance*
annoying certain lands of Villago Durbin
was taken from the ITASCA NEWS, a weekly newspaper,
regularly printed and published weekly in the English lan-
guage in the Village of Deer River, in said county and state,
for more than one year next preceeding the date of the first
publication hereinafter named and down to the present time,
and that during the whole time aforesaid he was printer and
publisher of said newspaper; that said Notice of *Ordinance*
annoying certain lands etc. was duly printed
and published in said newspaper for a period of *two*..
successive weeks, on Saturday of each week, commencing
on Saturday, the *12th* day of *January*... 1907., on
which last mentioned day it was first published, and ending
on Saturday, the *19th* day of *January*... 1907., on
which last mentioned day it was last published, upon which
days and times of publication aforesaid the said newspaper was reg-
ularly printed and published as aforesaid; but during all the time
aforesaid said newspaper was a collection of general and local news,
comment and miscellaneous literary items, and regularly issued and
published on Saturday of each week from a known office of publica-
tion, said office being equipped with the necessary materials, type,
presses, etc., and skilled workmen for doing the same, and has con-
sisted of not less than four pages, of more than five columns to the
page, each column not less than seventeen and three-fourths inches
in length, and never made up wholly of patents, plates and advertise-
ments, or either or any of them, and has not been substantially a dupli-
cate of any other newspaper, composed and existing as above set forth,
was published and printed in the English language weekly, and general-
ly circulated in Itasca County, for more than one year next preceeding
the date of the first publication of said notice; that the publisher of
said newspaper has filed with the county auditor of said Itasca county,
an affidavit setting forth the facts required by Section 2 of Chapter
23, of the laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1893.
