That she is a resident of St. Paul, Ramsey County, Minnesota, residing at 934 Grand Avenue, St. Paul, and Plaintiff in the action against the United States Steel Corporation.

That on or about the first of April 1929 she entered the plant, located at 2537 University Avenue, St. Paul, Minnesota, known as the United States Steel Products Company and the Illinois Steel Company, recognized and advertised as such.

That upon inquiry as to who was Superintendent of the Plant, Mr. Leonard El Douglas identified himself as Superintendent for the United States Steel Products Company and the Illinois Steel Company.

Further, that Mr. Douglas before realizing to whom he was speaking, informed the affiant that due to the fact that the United States^{Steel} Products Company is the United States Steel Corporation, he is Superintendent for the United States Steel Corporation also, and that exports of steel were being made and business transacted under the name of the United States Steel Products Company from the above address, and after due investigation and inquiry the affiant finds no articles filed with Secretary of State as required by the Laws of the State of Minnesota
