Dear Mr. Brown:

I have your letter of September the 11th with reference to your invoice, number 25840 to cover certified copy of articles of incorporation of the Hairdressers Association in the amount of two dollars, \$2.00.

You will perhaps remember that there was a slight misunderstanding with reference to this matter which I came over to see you about personally. The articles of incorporation which you sent me under that invoice did not contain the ammendment changing the name, and if you will remember on April the 14th I came over to your office accompanied by Mr. Williams, President of the Association and at that time your stenographer made out a new certified copy. At that time I paid in cash two amounts of one dollars (\$1.00), and one dollar and a half, (\$1.50). I am enclosing statements showing those amounts paid. As a matter of fact these payments were substituted by you for the prior invoice. Perhaps that explains the situation. In other words your invoice number 25840 was never paid by me, but I did pay two dollars and a half (\$2.50) on March 14th in cash to cover that transaction. I am enclosing these receipts and trust that this will straighten out the apparent discrepancy. I trust you will return the receipts to me for my files.
