

Ordinance No 15

ORDINANCE ANNEXING LAND TO VILLAGE.

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND TO THE VILLAGE OF FOLEY.

The Village Council of the Village of Foley, do ordain:-

SECTION I. That the following described tract of land, viz:-

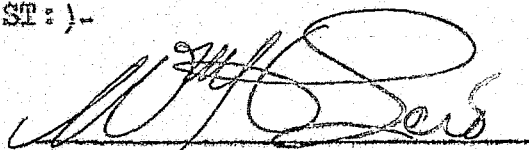
Commencing at a point Thirty-Three(33) feet west and Three Hundred forty six and one half Feet North of the South East Corner of the South West Quarter of Section Twenty Six(26) Township Thirty Seven(37) Range Twenty Nine(29); Running thence West parallel with South line of the above described Section Twenty Six(26) Two Hundred Nine (209) feet; Thence North and at right angles with the above mentioned section line One Hundred Four and one half(104) feet; thence East and parallel with the above described section line Two Hundred Nine feet(209); Thence South and at right angles with the above described section line and on the West side of the County Road, One Hundred and Four and one half (104 1/2) feet to the place of beginning,

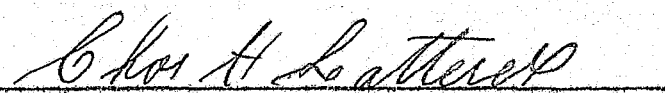
abutting upon and adjacent to the incorporated village of Foley, be and the same is hereby annexed to such village and shall become a part of such village as effectually as if it had been an original part thereof.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its publication and a certified copy thereof is filed with the County Auditor and the Secretary of state.

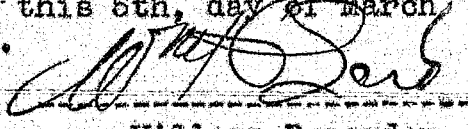

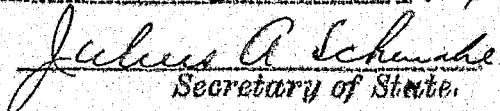
