
I, A.J. Veigel, Commissioner of Banks of the State

C E R T I F I C A T E

We, the undersigned having been appointed by the Village Council of the village of Lindstrom, in the County of Chisago and State of Minnesota to act as Judges at a special election of the electors of said Village to be held in the village Council Rooms of said Village on Tuesday, the 17th day of September, 1929 between the hours of 9 A.M. and 5 P.M., said special election having been called by said Council for the electors of said Village to vote upon the following proposition:- of detaching from said Village all that tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Chisago and State of Minnesota, and described as follows, to-wit:-

All that part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 33, Township 34, range 20, described as follows, to-wit:- beginning at a point in the South line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 33 feet West of the SE corner thereof; thence North parallel with and 33 feet distant West of the East line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 1236.2 feet to the South line of Newell Avenue, as shown by the plat of Lakeland Addition to Lindstrom on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for the County of Chisago aforesaid; thence West along the South line of Newell Avenue aforesaid 819.3 feet to the East line of Broadway in said Lakeland Addition; thence South along the East line of Broadway in said addition 400 feet to the North line of Sylvan Avenue in said Lakeland Addition; thence East along the North line of said Sylvan Avenue 200.7 feet; thence South across Sylvan Avenue aforesaid, and along the East line of Lot 1 in Block 8 of said Lakeland Addition 296 feet to the SE corner of said lot; thence West along the South line of said lot 200.7 feet to the East line of Broadway aforesaid; thence South along the East line of Broadway and a projection thereof to the South line of Newlander Avenue in said addition, 296 feet to said South line of Newlander Avenue; thence West 33 feet to the NE corner of Lot 2 in Block 10 of said Lakeland Addition; thence South 227.6 feet along the East line of Lot 2 aforesaid to the South line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ aforesaid; thence East along said South line 847.5 feet to the place of beginning; said tract or parcel comprising all the lots and blocks of Lakeland Addition aforesaid and the parts of the avenues and street therein vacated by order of the District Court of the State of Minnesota in and for said

County of Chisago, Nineteenth Judicial District, dated August 19th, 1929, a certified copy of which was filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of said County of Chisago on August 21st, 1929.

and notice of said election having been duly given as required by law, do hereby certify and return that we attended at the time and place fixed by said Council for holding said special election, and did thereupon take and subscribe an oath as required by law faithfully to discharge the duties required at said special election, and forthwith opened the polls by proclamation, and said special election proceeded by ballot without adjournment or intermission until closed at the hour of 5 O'clock in the afternoon of said day, and at which hour the polls were closed pursuant to proclamation thereof as required by law, and we then and there proceeded publicly to count and canvass the votes cast at said special election, and did find that the whole number of votes cast at said special election was 60; that 52 votes were cast in favor of the proposition for detaching said territory, and 8 votes were cast against the proposition of detaching said territory; that a majority of the votes or ballots cast at said election were cast in favor of detaching said territory.
