

An ordinance annexing additional territory to the incorporated limits of the village of Browerville, Todd Co., Minn. by virtue of proceedings under Chapter 281 of the acts of the legislature in its 1905 session.

The village council of the village of Browerville, Todd Co., Minn. do ordain as follows:

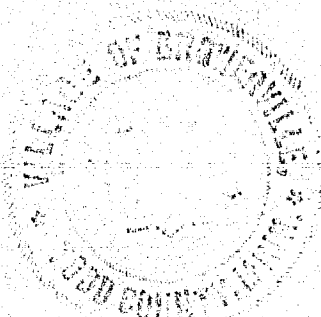
Section I. Whereas on the 11th day of August, 1905, Geo. H. Varce, Geo. A. Gunn, D.E. Sautbine, and Val. Sarff who are the sole and only voters residing on lots Six (6), SEven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), and Ten (10) Block No. 1, Basset's ^{revised} addition to the village of Browerville, have concurrently petitioned with D.E. Sautbine, Val Sarff, Jacob Sarff, and Alva Sarff who are the sole and only owners of said lots ~~above~~ ^{above} described asking that said property be annexed to and become a part of the incorporated limits of the village of Browerville as aforesaid, and whereas said petition conforms to the requirements of Chapter 281 of the acts of the Minnesota legislature at its 1905 session therefore be it ordained by the village council aforesaid.

Section II. That all of lots Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), and Ten (10), of Block No. one (1), of Basset's ^{revised} addition to the village of Browerville, Todd Co., Minn. be and the same are hereby annexed to, incorporated into, and made a part of the incorporated limits of the said village of Browerville as fully to all intents and purposes as though said above described lots had been included within the original incorporated limits.

Section III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect as soon as published and a certified copy is filed with the County Auditor of Todd Co. Minn. and with the Secretary of the State of Minnesota. Passed and adopted by the village of Browerville, Todd Co., Minn., this 24th day of August, 1905.

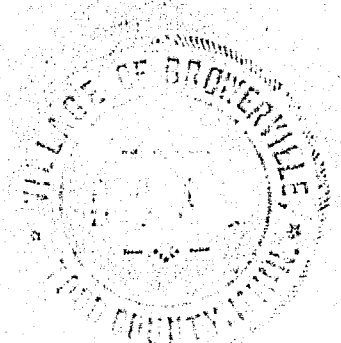
