----- The village council of the village of Roosevelt met at the office of the village clerk, to canvass the result of the electors vote cast at the special election held March 31, 1907 for the purpose of voting upon the question of constituting the village of Roosevelt a separate election and assessment district;

The certified returns of said election, filed with the clerk, were ordered spread upon the records of this meeting, as follows, to-wit-;

"We, the undersigned, judges and clerk of the Special Village Election of the village of Roosevelt, in the county of Roseau and state of Minnesota, held on the 31st day of March, 1907, at Sundquist's hall in the village of Roosevelt, pursuant to notice given, for the purpose of voting upon the question of "Constituting the village of Roosevelt a separate election and assessment district" as provided by Section 708 of the Revised laws of Minnesota for 1905,

DO HEREBY CERTIFY AND RETURN, that the polls of said election were duly opened by proclamation at the hour of ten o'clock A.M. of said day, and continued open until the hour of five o'clock of said day, at which hour the polls were duly closed, proclamation thereof having been duly given as provided by law

That after closing said polls we proceeded to canvass the vote cast, with the following result-;

The ballots cast in all, numbered 20 The vote was as follows-;

For constituting the village of Roosevelt a separate election and assessment district"--- "Yes", received 20 votes

"For constituting the village of Roosevelt a separate election and assessment district"-----"No", received None votes.

WHEREUPON, the result aforesaid was by the judges publicly stated, and the question of constituting the village of Roosevelt a separate election and assessment district, declared carried.

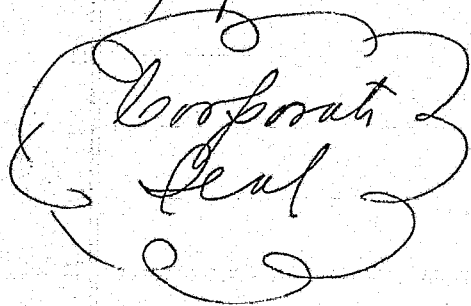
