of the Election in the above entitled action by the Board of County
Commissioners of St. Louis County, Minn., do hereby certify,

That pursuant to Notice duly posted and published by order
of said Board, on the 2nd day of April, 1907 at the General Store
of J. F. Ryan being the place designated in the said Notice, between
9 and 10 A.M. of said day, the voters assembled at said place elected
Rowe McGamus Clerk of said Election; that said election of Clerk was
approved by the undersigned; that thereupon, the undersigned took and
subscribed the oaths hereto attached and marked "Exhibit A"; that the
said Clerk took and subscribed the oath hereto attached and marked
"Exhibit B"; that the undersigned thereupon proclaimed the polls open;
