

Ordinance Number 43.

An ordinance to include certain platted lands adjoining the corporate limits of the Village of Graceville, Big Stone County, Minnesota, according to the petition of the occupants of said land, filed with the Village Recorder on April 2, 1907.

The Village Council of the Village of Graceville, Big Stone County, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

Sec. I. A petition having been duly signed by the owners of the platted portion of Government Lot 3, in Section 9, in Township 124 of Range 45, Big Stone County, Minnesota, and described in said petition as that portion of Government Lot 3 in Section 9 in Township 124 of Range 45 which is South and adjoining Government Lot 2 in Section 9, Township 124, Range 45, and between the South line of Government Lot 2 and the South line of Lake Avenue and east of the prolongation South of the West line of said Government Lot 2 in said Section 9, Township 124, Range 45, said county, and said land which platted portion of said land being the platted portion of the Village of Graceville, which said petition having been duly filed with the recorder, with the plat of said land attached, of said Village on the 2nd day of April, 1907, praying that said land be incorporated and be included in the Village limits of the Village of Graceville as provided by Section 707 of the Revised Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1905.

Sec. II. It appearing to the satisfaction of said Village Council that it would be for the best interests of said petitioners and of the Village of Graceville to have said property included in the corporate limits of the said Village of Graceville, it is hereby extended to include the above described land and the whole thereof, and that said land is hereby declared to be a part of the Village of Graceville.

Sec. III. This ordinance will take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication.

That the publisher of said newspaper prior to the date of the publication of said notice filed with the County Auditor of said Big Stone County an affidavit setting forth the facts required by Section 2, Chapter 33, of the Laws of the State of Minnesota, for the year 1893.
