## PROPOSED AMENDMENT.

## TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF MOORHEAD.

To the Honorable H. C. Nordlie, Mayor, and the Council of the City of Moorhead:

We, the undersigned, appointed on the 7th day of October, 1926, by the Honorable the District Court of the State of Minnesota, in and for the County of Clay, as a Charter Commission for the said City of Moorhead, do hereby respectfully submit the following amendment to the Charter adopted by the said City of Moorhead on May 22nd, 1900, to-wit:

AMEND Subsection 7, of Section 94, of Chapter 5 of said Charter so as to read as follows:

"The Poor Fund is created for the purpose of providing moneys to be paid out in taking care of the poor of the city. This fund shall be supported by taxation, but no larger amount shall be levied therefor in any one year than two and a half mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of the taxable property of the city. Provided, that for the year 1929 three and a half mills on the dollar may be levied."
