Dear Sir:

This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter of January 3 wherein you ask to be advised with reference to certain election dates.

You are advised as follows:

1. That the date of the next state primary election is June 16, 1930.

2. That the last day on which candidates for nomination at such state primary election may file affidavits of candidacy is:

(a) For state offices, including judge of the district court, member of congress, and member of the state legislature, is May 7, 1930.

(b) For county offices is May 27, 1930.

3. That the last day on which a candidate may be nominated by petition or certificate of voters for any office, under §§ 329-332, General Statutes 1923, is October 4, 1930, since October 5th falls on a Sunday.

4. That the date of the next general election is November 4, 1930.
