BE IT RESOLVED By the Village Council of the Village of Good Thunder, County of Blue Earth, State of Minnesota, as follows:

That at a regular village election held at the Village Hall in the Village of Good Thunder, Blue Earth County, Minnesota, on December 3, 1929, the question of relinquishment of the charter of the Village of Good Thunder and the reincorporation under Chapter 9 of the Revised Laws of 1905 and the Sections thereunder applicable to Villages of this class and as the same have been amended, was duly submitted and voted on by the voters of said Village of Good Thunder, and that the vote cast on said proposition as canvassed by us is as follows:

There were cast for re-incorporation 51 votes

There were cast against re-incorporation 3 votes.
