

I HEREBY APPOINT John I. Levin, of St. Paul, Minnesota, as special assistant attorney general to act on the state fair grounds from August 30 to September 6, 1930, both dates inclusive, in all matters that require the immediate action of an adviser to the state agricultural society or of a prosecuting attorney.

This appointment is made upon recommendation of the board of managers of the state agricultural society and upon my judgment that the public welfare will be promoted thereby. The compensation is hereby fixed at \$15.00 per day, to be paid from the funds of said society.
