The Village Council of the Village of Wilton in the County of Beltrami and State of Minnesota do hereby certify that a special election was duly held in said Village according to law on the 15th day of June, 1907, between the hours 10 o'clock A.M., and 4 o'clock P.M., of that day as appears by the minutes of election hereto attached.

That the votes cast at said election were duly canvassed by the said Village Council on the 15th day of June 1907, at a meeting of said Village Council held for that purpose.

That eighteen votes were cast at said election upon the question submitted; viz:- That the following territory comprising and embraced in the limits of the Village of Wilton be and are hereby set aside as a separate election and assessment district according to law, described by metes and bounds as follows: commencing at the Northwest corner of Section Thirty-two (32), in Township One hundred and forty-seven (147) North of Range Thirty-four (34) running thence in an easterly direction on and along the section line to the Northeast corner of Section Thirty-four (34) in said Township, running thence in a southerly direction on and along the section line to the Southeast corner of said Section thirty-four (34), running thence in ~~an~~ a westerly direction on and along the Township and section line to the Southwest corner of said Section thirty-two (32), running thence in a northerly direction on and along the section line to said point of commencement, comprising and containing Sections Thirty-two, thirty-three and thirty-four, in said Township One hundred forty-seven North of Range thirty-four West.

That at said election eighteen (18) votes were cast in favor of said proposition so submitted as aforesaid and the said

Village Council of Wilton declared the proposition duly carried and the said real premises hereinbefore described and contained within the limits of the said Village of Wilton be and they hereby are set aside as a separate election and assessment district according to law.
