

A REGULATION RELATING TO THE TAKING OF MUSKRATS IN THE YEAR 1930

By virtue of authority conferred by General Statutes 1923, Section 5542, as amended by Laws 1925, Chapter 380, and Laws 1929, Chapter 418, I, George W. Mc Cullough, Commissioner of Game and Fish of the State of Minnesota, do hereby prescribe the following regulation relating to the taking of muskrats in the year 1930, to be known as Regulation No. 3.

No. 3. Muskrats may be taken in any county in the State of Minnesota in the manner and under the conditions prescribed by law during the period commencing at twelve o'clock noon on March 20th, 1930, and continuing to and closing at twelve o'clock noon on April 15th, 1930. This regulation is subject to amendment or rescission at any time as provided by law.
