

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

Between Sweeney Detective Bureau, Incorporated, here-
in called the bureau, and the State of Minnesota, herein called
the state.

The bureau, in consideration of a monthly charge for
the service, will call at the office of the secretary of state
in the State Capitol Building, at St. Paul, at nine-thirty in
the morning of each banking day during the time this agreement
is in effect, with an armored car accompanied by guards, and
will receive and escort from the cashier's office of the motor
vehicle department to its said van, and transport therein from
the Capitol Building to the First National Bank and the Empire
National Bank, in St. Paul, the messenger employed by the secre-
tary of state to take to and deposit in that bank the money
and other cash items received in payment of motor vehicle taxes,
and while this messenger and the moneys and other cash items
are in the possession of the messenger while being so escorted
and transported will guarantee safe conduct of the messenger
and the moneys and other cash items in his possession, and will
make good to the state any loss it may sustain through its
failure to keep this condition, with the understanding, however,
that the obligation of the bureau to make good such loss shall
not exceed one hundred thousand dollars in any instance.

The responsibility of the bureau for the safeguarding
of the funds in the possession of the messenger shall commence
when the messenger of the secretary of state leaves the cashier's
office under the protection of the guards supplied by the bureau,
and shall terminate when the messenger arrives with his deposit
at the teller's window in the bank.

For the service and insurance stated herein the state
will pay to the bureau one hundred dollars, in monthly payments
made according to the usual course of state payment.

This agreement shall take effect on the date hereof and shall continue in effect to and including the third day of April, 1930.
