Dear Mr. Holm:-

About a year ago, Mr. Brown of your office raised the question as to the proper place for filing the so-called "wholesale dealer's bonds". Up to this time they had been filed in the Secretary of State's office, but Mr. Brown felt that they should be filed with the Dept. of Agri., Dairy & Food, due to the large amount of extra time necessary for filing, as well as looking up inquiries relative to these bonds. Since that time we have been filing them with the Dept. of Agri., Dairy & Food, but there are quite a large number of the old bonds still on file in your office and we believe that it would be the proper thing to have all these bonds together because we frequently have to check up on them.

The bonds that are now on file/your office should be transferred to the Department of Agriculture, Dairy & Food and I wish you would take such steps as are necessary to have them transferred from the office of Secretary of State to the office of Commissioner of Agri., Dairy & Food.

I return herewith letter addressed to you by the commissioner of agriculture under date of November 27, 1929, requesting the right to withdraw from the files of your office

BONDS OF DEALERS AT WHOLESALE.

I find that this department, in a communication addressed to you under date of June 14, 1928, directed attention to a provision in the act under which these bonds are required directing that they be filed in the office of the commissioner of agriculture. Our communication closed with this:

"The conclusion reached is that these bonds of dealers at wholesale, when approved and filed by the commissioner, should be retained in his office. Those that you have received and filed up to this date may very well be retained in your custody until otherwise directed."

The request included in the communication you have now received from the commissioner of agriculture constitutes a sufficient direction as to the disposition of these bonds. You may allow them to be withdrawn, taking the receipt of the commissioner therefor which you may attach to the correspondence relating thereto.
