

RESOLUTIONS

Concerning the Re-Incorporation of the Village
of WINNEBAGO, in the County of Faribault,
State of Minnesota.

Whereas the following Resolutions of the Village Council of
the village of Winnebago, were duly submitted to the electors
legal voters of the village, for adoption or rejection, at a
special election called duly for that purpose on the 3rd. day
of July, 1907.

Resolved, by the village council of the village of Winnebago,
That it is expedient and desirable that the village relinquish
its present organization under the General Statutes of 1894
being Chapter 145 of the General Laws of the A. D. 1885, and
the acts amendatory thereof, and become organized and re-
incorporated under the provisions of Chapter Nine (9) Revised
Laws of 1905, and the acts amendatory thereof.

And whereas at said Election said resolutions was by a major-
ity of the votes cast duly adopted, to-wit there was cast "For
Re-incorporation" Yes 181 votes, and " For Re-incorporation"
No 36 votes.

Now therefore be it resolved by the village council of the
Village of Winnebago

That the result of the said election was that the Village of
Winnebago thereby relinquished and surrendered its charter
under the General Laws of the State of Minnesota, being
Chapter 145 of the General Laws of 1885, and Chapter 10 of
the General Statutes of 1894, and amendments thereto, and is
to be governed hereafter under and by the provisions of
Chapter Nine (9) of the Revised Laws of 1905, and the acts
amendatory thereof.
