

CERTIFICATE OF SPECIAL ELECTION OF THE

To the County Auditor of Douglas County, Minnesota, GREETINGS:

We, the undersigned members of the Village Council of the Village of Miltona, Douglas County, Minnesota, do hereby certify that on the 28th day of April, 1930, at the Village of Miltona, Douglas County, Minnesota a special election was duly held according to law at which time the following question was submitted to be voted on by the electors of the said Village of Miltona:

"Shall the Village of Miltona, Minnesota, be separated from the Township of Miltona for election and assessment purposes."

We further certify that there were thirty-four votes cast at such election on the proposition and that the result of said election was as follows: Yes--34; No--none. We further certify that the question voted on was unanimously carried by the votes of the electors of said village; that the result of such election is evidenced by the filing in the Village Clerk's office, the poll list of those voting, the tally list compiled from the count of the votes, the certificate of canvas made by the judges of said election to the Village Council, the oath of the judges of the election, a copy of the special notice calling such meeting and the affidavits of the proper posting thereof; that the said election was held according to law and that this certificate is made to the County Auditor of Douglas County, Minnesota, for the purpose that the result of such election and separation of the Village of Miltona from the Township of Miltona for assessment and election purposes may be recorded in the proper county and state offices.
