Ordinance No 29

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF THIS VILLAGE FROM HOLDING
TO HOLDINGFORD.

The Village Council of Holding do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Name to be changed. The name of this
municipality shall be and hereby is changed from the Village
of Holding to the Village of Holdingford as duly designated
as the name of the post office in this village.

SECTION 2. Effect of Ordinance. This ordinance shall
take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and
publication according to law, and upon certified copies hereof
being filed with the County auditor, the State Auditor and with
the Secretary of State.
