
WHEREAS, it has been represented to the Commissioner of Game and Fish that minnows are in danger of undue depletion in the waters of Hartley and Long Lakes in Township 59 North and 23 and 24 West, and Reiley, Diamond and Hill Lakes in Township 56 North and 24 West, Itasca County, State of Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Game and Fish has investigated and has presented me with the results of his investigation, and has recommended that additional protection be given minnows in the above named lakes to prevent their undue depletion.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Theodore Christianson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of and pursuant to authority vested in me by Section 134, Chapter 400, S. L. Minnesota, 1929, Sec. 5640, G. S. 1923, do hereby order that no minnows be taken from Hartley and Long Lakes, and from Reiley, Diamond and Hill Lakes, Itasca County, State of Minnesota, to be sold or bought and transported for commercial purposes during the season of 1930.

This order shall remain in force until the close of the 1931 regular session of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota unless sooner revoked or modified.
