Extending additional protection to Minnows in Bald Eagle Lake, located in the northeast corner of Township 30 N., Range 22 W., Ramsey County, and the southwest corner of Township 31 N., Range 21 W., Washington County, and the southeast corner of Township 31 N., Range 22 W., Anoka County, State of Minnesota.


WHEREAS, it has been represented to the Commissioner of Game and Fish that minnows are in danger of undue depletion in the Waters of Bald Eagle Lake, located in the northeast corner of Township 30 N., Range 22 W., Ramsey County, and the southwest corner of Township 31 N., Range 21 W., Washington County, and the southeast corner of Township 31 N., Range 22 W., Anoka County, State of Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Game and Fish has investigated and has presented me with the results of his investigation, and has recommended that additional protection be given minnows in the above named lake to prevent their undue depletion.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Theodore Christianson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of and pursuant to authority vested in me by Section 134, Chapter 400, S.L. Minnesota, 1929, Section 5640, G.S. 1923, do hereby order that no minnows be taken from Bald Eagle Lake, located in Ramsey, Washington and Anoka Counties, at any time or for any purpose during the season of 1930.

This order shall remain in force until the close of the 1931 regular session of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota unless sooner revoked or modified.
