Sir:

WHEREAS, on December 1st, 1930 there will be due and payable semi-annual interest on outstanding Rural Credit Bonds in the amount of \$330,875.00, and whereas there is only \$230,875.00 available in the Rural Credit Interest Fund for that purpose, it is necessary and expedient to offer for sale certificates of indebtedness as provided by Sec. 12 of Chapter 215, Laws 1923, and acts amendatory thereof, in the sum of \$100,000.00 for the purpose of obtaining additional funds with which to meet such payments, and

WHEREAS, It is provided by Section 4 of said Chapter 215, Laws 1923, that before issuing any bonds or certificates it shall be the duty of the Department of Rural Credit to furnish to the Governor a financial statement showing the condition of the business of the Department.

THEREFORE, We beg leave to submit the following financial statement:

Regular meeting of the Department of Rural Credit held at its office in the Hamm Building, St. Paul, Minnesota, on the 25th day of November, 1930. Members present: Ole O. Sogeng, and H.H. Flowers. Ole O. Sogeng, Chairman, presiding.

H. H. Flowers, a member of said Department, offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLVED By the Department of Rural Credit, that under the authority conferred by amendment to the Constitution of the State of Minnesota, and under the authority of Chapter 225, Laws of Minnesota, 1923, and acts amendatory thereof, there shall be and there are hereby directed to be issued, payable by the State of Minnesota, bearing interest at the rate of four and fifteen one hundredths (4.15) per centum per annum, certificate of indebtedness to the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00). Said certificate to be dated and issued in the following denomination, viz: One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) dated November 26th, 1930, numbered thirty-two thousand seven hundred and forty-seven (32,747), and shall become due and payable on the 26th day of November, 1932, with interest thereon due and payable at maturity. Both principal and interest shall be payable at the office of the State Treasurer, St. Paul, Minnesota, or at The First National Bank, St. Paul, Minnesota, or at the Bankers Trust Company of New York, N.Y., or at such other Bank or Trust Company as may be appointed by said State in said Cities of St. Paul and New York, at the option of the holder. The said certificate shall be exempt from all general taxes, State, County and Municipal, and are not subject to State Income Tax in Minnesota. The said certificate is a part of a total authorized issue of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00), provided for by Chapter 225, Laws of Minnesota, 1923, and acts

amendatory thereof, and by the amendment to Section 10 of Article IX of the Constitution of Minnesota, adopted at the general election of 1928.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the form of said certificate shall be substantially as follows:

(\$_____) on the _____ day of _____, 19_____, and to pay interest thereon at the rate of four and fifteen one hundredths (4.15) per centum per annum, due and payable _____,

both principal and interest of this certificate being payable in lawful money of the United States, at the office of the State Treasurer, St. Paul, Minnesota, or at the option of the holder, at The First National Bank, St. Paul, Minnesota, or at the Bankers Trust Company, New York, N.Y., or at such other Bank or Trust Company as may be appointed by said State in said Cities of St. Paul and New York.

This certificate of indebtedness is issued under and pursuant to and in strict conformity with the Constitution and Laws of the State of Minnesota, including among others, Article IX, Section Ten, of the Constitution, as amended, and Chapter

LBG, Laws of Minnesota, 1903, and acts amendatory thereto, for the purpose of raising money for the use of the Rural Credit Interest Fund of said State, to pay interest due on outstanding Rural Credit Bonds and be disbursed as directed by the said statute.

This certificate is exempt from all general taxes, State, County and Municipal, and is not subject to State Income Tax in Minnesota.

It is hereby certified, recited and declared, that all acts, conditions and things required to exist, happen and be performed precedent to and in issuance of this certificate, have existed, happened and been performed in due time, form and manner as required by law, and that this certificate and the issue of which it forms a part, together with all other indebtedness of said State, does not exceed any constitutional or statutory limitation of indebtedness. The full faith, credit and resources of the State of Minnesota hereby are irrevocably pledged for the prompt and punctual payment of the principal and interest of this certificate.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the STATE OF MINNESOTA, By its Rural Credit Department, has caused this certificate to be issued under the Great Seal of the State, and to be signed by the Chairman of said Department in behalf of the Department and attested by the Secretary of State of Minnesota, the form thereof having been approved by the Attorney General of said State, and this certificate to be dated the _____ day of _____, 19____.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the full faith, credit and resources of the State of Minnesota are hereby pledged for the prompt and punctual payment of the principal and interest of the said certificate, and for the assurance of the purchaser and holder of the said certificate, the Department of Rural Credit hereby agrees that it will, when necessary, issue and dispose of Tax Levy Certificates, as authorized by said Chapter 225, Laws of Minnesota, 1923, and acts amendatory thereof, from time to time in an amount sufficient to pay the principal and interest of the said certificate, and the Department shall certify the amount of the said Tax Levy Certificates so issued, and the maturity dates thereof, to the State Auditor, who shall thereupon, as required by law, make a tax levy against all the taxable property of the State, in the same manner as other taxes are levied, in an amount sufficient to pay the said Tax Levy Certificates at maturity, together with interest thereon and that the proceeds of the said Tax Levy Certificates shall be applied in the payment of the principal and interest of the said certificate.

H. H. Flowers seconded the motion, the same being put to a vote by the Chairman. H. H. Flowers voted "aye!" Ole O. Sogeng voted "aye." Whereupon the Chairman declared said resolu-


tion duly adopted.


