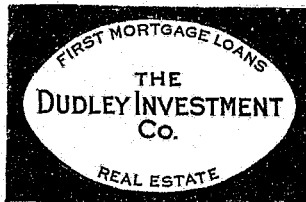

Dear Sir:-

According to the records at the County courthouse in Grand Rapids, Minnesota, the State of Minnesota owns Lots 2, 3 and 4, Section 26; Lots 1 and 2, Section 28; and Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4, Section 34; all in Township 62 N., Range 24 W., 4th P.M., State of Minnesota, which Lots front upon Deer Lake in Itasca County.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, Andrew F. Tribble of 925 New York Life Building, Kansas City, Missouri intends to apply to the Commissioner of the General Land Office of the United States at Washington, D.C. for the survey of an island lying in said Deer Lake, said island being across the lake from the State land.

Said Deer Lake is situated in Sections 14, 15, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28 and 34, Township 62 North, Range 24 West, 4th Principal Meridian, State of Minnesota; and said island for which application for survey is to be made is the only island in said lake and is situated in the northwest part of same.

It is contended by the undersigned that said island is public land of the United States and is subject to survey and disposition as such.

Protest, if any, against such proposed survey should be filed with the Commissioner of the General Land Office at Washington, D.C., within 30 days of the receipt of this notice.

This notice is being sent to all the landowners having frontage on said Deer Lake and to the Attorney General of the State of Minnesota.
