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RESOLUTION FOR REINTEGRATION

RE-INTEGRATION

THE VILLAGE OF

MANHATTAN BEACH

We, the undersigned legal voters who have resided for more than two years within the territory hereinafter described, do hereby respectfully petition the County Board of the County of Crow Wing, Minnesota, to call an election for the purpose of determining the proposed re-incorporation of the Village of Manhattan Beach pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 9, Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 1111 and Acts amendatory thereto.

The territory proposed to be re-incorporated consists of:

Government Lot 4 and the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 31, Government Lots 1, 2 & 3, and the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of section 32, the west half of the southwest quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the west half of the northwest quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 33, except the south 75 feet of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) excepting the easterly 100 feet thereof, and the north 75 feet of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) excepting the easterly 100 feet thereof, and all of Section 30 excepting therefrom a strip of land 100 feet wide, 75 feet north and 75 feet south of the centerline of the now existing State Aid Road No. 1 which travels in a easterly and westerly direction along the north quarter line of said section, all being in Township 132 North, Range 27 West, Crow Wing County, Minn.

Said territory consists of certain property which has been platted into blocks and lots, which plat has been duly and legally certified according to the laws of Minnesota and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds in said county, and is designated as follows, to-wit: "Block 1 and 2 Manhattan Beach Entrance Addition" and it includes unplatted territory adjacent thereto, all as set forth in more detail in Exhibit "A" hereto attached and made a part hereof. Said territory contains a resident population of eighty-seven people. The quantity of land embraced in the proposed village and shown on a plat thereof, which is submitted together with this petition, amounts to approximately one thousand thirty-five (1,035) acres.

That the proposed name of the village shall be "Manhattan Beach."

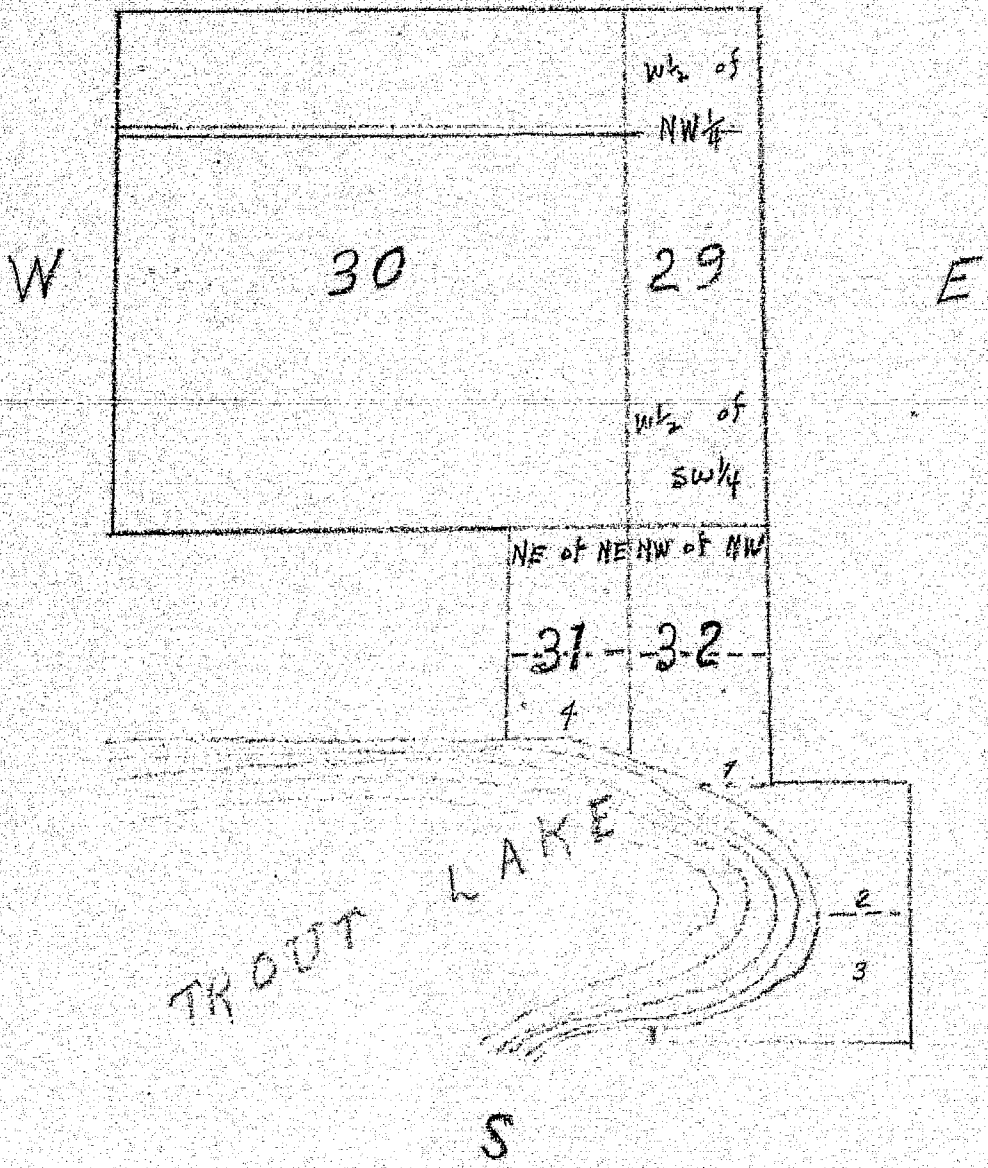




