P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS, the Selective Training and Service Act of 1940 declares that in a free society the obligations and privileges of military training and service shall be shared generally according to the provisions of a fair and just system of selective compulsory military training and service, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions thereof, the President of the United States has by proclamation designated July 1, 1941 for a second registration thereunder, and has decreed that between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 9:00 P.M. on that day, it shall be the duty of every male citizen of the United States and of every male alien residing in the United States, who on or before July 1, 1941 and subsequent to October 16, 1940 has attained the twenty-first anniversary of the day of his birth and every male citizen of the United States and every male alien residing in the continental United States who, on October 16, 1940 had attained the twenty-first anniversary of his birth and had not attained the thirty-sixth anniversary of his birth and has not heretofore been registered under the Selective Training and Service Act of 1940, to present himself before a duly designated registration official.

in the area in which he has his permanent home or in which he may happen to be on that day, and

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has called upon the Governors of the Several States and all officials and agents of the Several States and political subdivisions thereof and on local boards and agents thereof to do and perform all acts and services necessary to accomplish effective and complete registration;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HAROLD E. STASSEN, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, under and by virtue of the authority vested in me by the aforesaid Selective Training and Service Act of 1940, and the regulations promulgated pursuant thereto by the President, do hereby call upon all officers and agents of the State of Minnesota and political subdivisions thereof, members of local boards and all other persons who have volunteered to act as registrars, voluntarily to perform all duties which may be required of them to accomplish this registration.

I ask that the flag be displayed on registration day on all public buildings and all private buildings and homes as an acknowledgment by our people of the importance of the day. I further ask that all public and private business institutions of the State give employees who are required to register the necessary

time from their duties to comply with their legal obligation.
