The undersigned, being more than twenty-five of the

voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, do hereby petition your honorable body to call an election for the purpose of determining whether or not the said territory shall be incorporated as a Village under sections 700 to 705 Revised Laws 1905 and Gen. Laws, 1907, Chap. 255 and 270. Your petitioners respectfully show that Lots 1 & 2 and the SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 19 and Lot 4 and SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, within the territory hereinafter described has been platted into Lots and Blocks and the plats thereof have been duly and legally certified according to the laws of the state of Minnesota, and have been filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of Becker County, Minnesota; that said territory contains a resident population of 212 people and that all the unplatteed territory hereinafter described adjoins the platted portion and is so conditioned as to properly be subject to village government; that a census of the resident population of the said territory has been taken by D. E. Peake, A.
