

Affidavit of Publication

W. J. Baker being duly sworn, deposes and says that he now is and during all the times hereinafter mentioned has been the manager or printer in charge of the LeSueur Center Leader, a weekly newspaper, printed and published in the Village of LeSueur Center, in said LeSueur County, State of Minnesota, on Thursday of each week;

That he has knowledge of the facts and knows personally that the printed notice hereto attached, cut from the columns of said newspaper, was inserted, printed and published in said newspaper once in each week for one weeks, and that all of said publications were made in the English language. That said notice was first inserted, printed and published on Thursday, the 11th day of December, 1930 and was printed and published in said newspaper on each and every Thursday thereafter until and including Thursday, the _____ day of _____, 1930.

That during all the times aforesaid, said newspaper was qualified as a medium of official and legal publications as required by sections 3 and 4 of chapter 484, Session Laws of Minnesota, 1921, and that it has complied with all the requirements that constitute a legal newspaper as defined in said sections 3 and 4, to-wit: that for more than one year last past from the date of the first publication of said notice, said newspaper has been

(1) Printed from the place from which it purports to be issued in the English language, and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least four pages, with five columns to the page, each seventeen and three quarters inches long.

(2) Issued once each week from a known office, established in such place for publication and equipped with skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same.

(3) Made up to contain general and local news, comment and miscellany, not wholly duplicating any other publication, and not entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements, or any or either of them.

(4) Circulated in and near its place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, and that prior to the date of the first publication of said notice the manager or printer in charge of said newspaper having knowledge of the facts, filed in the office of the county auditor of said county of LeSueur, state of Minnesota, an affidavit showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper as required and set forth in section 3 of chapter 484, Session Laws Minnesota, 1921.

That the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z both inclusive, of the size and kind of type used in the composition, printing and publication of said legal advertisement hereunto attached, viz: abcdefghijklmnopqrstuvwxyz

ORDINANCE NO. 57.

An Ordinance To Change The Name
Of The Village Of LeSueur Center
From The Name "LeSueur Cen-
ter" To The Name "Center."

WHEREAS, on November 22, 1930, there was presented to the Village Council a petition signed by 159 legal voters of the village, praying that the name of the village be changed from "LeSueur Center" to the name "Center"; and,

WHEREAS, the council thereupon by a resolution duly adopted submitted the question of such change of name to the voters of the village, to be voted thereon at the village election to be held on December 2, 1930, and directed the Village Clerk to give due notice thereof, as required by the statute, and to have the question printed on the official ballot; and,

WHEREAS, notice that the said question was submitted to the voters of the village and would be voted upon at said election to be held December 2, 1930, was duly given and posted by the Village Clerk, as required by law; and,

WHEREAS, the said question was duly printed upon the official ballot used at said election, in the following language: "Shall the name of this village be changed from 'LeSueur Center' to the name 'Center'; and,

WHEREAS, at said village election so held on December 2, 1930, there were cast 484 votes in all, of which 263 votes were in favor of such change and 192 votes were against such change; and,

WHEREAS, the majority of the votes so cast at said election are in favor of such change of name;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority so given,

The Village Council of the Village of LeSueur Center, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. That the name of this village be, and hereby is, changed from the name "LeSueur Center" to the name "Center."

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after December 15, 1930.


