AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend Section 55, as contained in Chapter 8 of the Duluth City Charter by adding thereto an addition sub-Division Numbered 8, which reads as follows:

"8. Bonds in an amount not exceeding \$570,000.00 for the benefit of the Permanent Improvement Fund to be used only for the planning of a City Sewage Disposal System, and toward the completion of the same."

The bonds issued under authority of this subdivision shall be serial bonds, and shall not be sold at less than the per value thereof, the principal of which shall be payable in as nearly equal annual serial installments as possible, and not longer than twenty (20) years from their dates. Said bonds shall be payable at such place or places as the Council shall determine and shall draw a rate of interest not exceeding five (5%) per cent per annum.

The Council shall annually cause to be levied a tax sufficient in amount to pay such portion of said bonds as will mature during the next succeeding year.
