FINDINGS AND
APPRaisal.

On the 21st day of August, 1907, four of the County Commissioners of the County of Koochiching, in the State of Minnesota, acting as such Commissioners in behalf of the said County of Koochiching, petitioned His Excellency the Governor of the State of Minnesota, in writing representing that on the 19th day of December, 1906, the said County of Koochiching was detached from the County of Itasca, in the said State of Minnesota, by proclamation of the Governor, and praying that three disinterested persons be appointed pursuant to the provisions of Section 393 of the Revised Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1905, to appraise the value of the Court House, Jail, Sheriff's Residence and certain buildings located on a tract of land used by the said Itasca County as a Poor Farm, which said buildings were and are the public buildings belonging to the original County of Itasca and now situated within the borders of Itasca County as formed and set off by said proclamation.

In pursuance of said petition His Excellency Governor John A. Johnson did on the 6th day of September, A.D. 1907, duly appoint the undersigned, M. C. Tiffet, Thomas Downs and Einar Hoidal as commissioners and appraisers to determine the value of said County property, the County Commissioners of said two Counties having met on the 21st day of August, 1907, and endeavored, but failed, to agree

upon the value of said County buildings. On the said 6th day of September, 1907, the undersigned duly accepted the appointment made by the Governor as aforesaid and duly qualified and made and filed their oaths as such appraisers. On the 20th and 21st days of September, 1907, the undersigned Commissioners made a personal inspection of and investigation into the value of said buildings, that is to say, the said Court House, County Jail and Sheriff's Residence and the County Buildings situated upon the said Poor Farm, and received evidence in regard to the same.

Now, upon a full consideration of the premises, we find that the value of said buildings and all thereof, was on the 19th day of December, 1906, the sum of Eighty-eight thousand, seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$88,750.00), and no more, and we hereby appraise the value of said buildings at said sum of Eighty-eight thousand, seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$88,750.00) on said 19th day of December, 1906.
