RUUD, of said county, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that he now is and during all the time hereinafter mentioned has been publisher of the newspaper known as the "Dawson Sentinel" and knows the facts hereinafter stated: That said newspaper, during all the time hereinafter set forth, and for more than one year next preceding the date of the first publication hereinafter mentioned, has been printed in the English language, weekly, at the village of Dawson, in said county, and generally circulated in said village and county; that said newspaper is a collection of reading matter in column and sheet form, the matter consisting of general and local news, comments and miscellaneous literary items, printed weekly at an established office and known place of business, equipped with the necessary materials and skilled workmen for preparing and printing the same in whole or in part at said village at which it is dated, and consists of at least four pages of at least five columns to each page, each column being not less than seventeen and three-fourths inches long, or its equivalent in space, and that the proprietor and publisher has during all the time hereinafter mentioned and does now print, publish and deliver at each regular issue not less than 240 complete copies of such publication to paying subscribers; that the publisher of said newspaper has filed with the county auditor of the county wherein said newspaper is published an affidavit in writing and printing, subscribed by the affiant, and sworn to before an officer authorized to administer oaths, stating the name of the town, county, city or village where said newspaper is printed and published, and whether said newspaper is a daily, tri-weekly, or weekly newspaper, and the day of the week on which said newspaper is issued, and that the number of the regular paid subscribers of said newspaper exceed 240; that said newspaper is in all respects entitled to publish any legal notices required by law, and has fully complied with all the requirements of the laws of the state of Minnesota; that the annexed printed notice hereto attached and made a part hereof was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was published in said newspaper

for successive weeks, at least once in each week.

## CHAPTER 49.

### ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LOTS AND BLOCKS TO THE VILLAGE OF DAWSON.

The village council of the village of Dawson ordain as follows:  
Section 1. That the following described lots and blocks, or lands, to-wit: Commencing at quarter corner in the east boundary line of section numbered twenty (20), township one (1), range forty-three (43), county of Lac qui Parle, state of Minnesota, running thence north on said section line 100 feet, thence west 352 feet, thence south 300 feet, thence west 352 feet, thence south 279 feet, thence east 1,310 1/2 feet, to place of beginning, which tract of land has been surveyed, laid out and platted as "Hoidale's first addition to Dawson," containing the following described lots and blocks, to-wit: Lots numbered one to twelve, inclusive, in block "A"; lots numbered one to six, inclusive, in block "B"; and lots numbered one to five, inclusive, in block "C", lying upon and incorporated in the village of Dawson, the same are annexed to such village, and becoming a part of such village, as effectually as they had been originally a part thereof.  
Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after it is passed and published at Dawson, Minnesota, November 12th,


