

M. and 5 o'clock P.M., at which time and place the resident electors thereof will vote for or against incorporation under the Revised Laws, 1905, as provided by law.

To the Honorable, The Board of County Commissioners
Mahnomen, Minnesota.

Gentlemen:

We the undersigned, legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter mentioned and described to be incorporated as a village, respectfully petition your Honorable body to call an election for the determination of such proposed incorporation, and we represent that a census has been taken of the resident population of said territory, a copy of which is hereto attached and marked Exhibit "A" and herewith made a part hereof. The territory to be embraced shall be the following, to-wit:- The southeast quarter of section twenty-four, the north half of the "northeast" quarter of section twenty-five and the east half of the southwest quarter of section twenty-four, all in township one hundred forty-three north of range forty-two west of the 6th P. M. in Minnesota, a plat of which territory is hereto attached and marked Exhibit "B" and herewith made a part hereof. The boundaries of said territory shall be as follows:-Beginning at the southeast corner post of section twenty-four township one hundred forty-three, north of range forty-two west of the 6th P. M. in Minnesota, thence running in a northerly direction along the section line one hundred sixty rods more or less according to the Government survey to the quarter post on the east line of section twenty-four; thence in a westerly direction along the quarter line in said section two hundred forty rods more or less according to the Government survey to the sixteenth post on said line; thence in a southerly direction along the line between the east half and the west half of the southwest quarter of section twenty-four, one hundred sixty rods more or less according to the Government survey to the sixteenth post on the south line of section twenty-four; thence in an easterly direction along the south line of section twenty-four eighty rods more or less according to the Government survey to the quarter post on said section line; thence in a southerly direction along the quarter line of section twenty-five, eighty rods more or less according to the Government survey to the sixteenth post on said quarter line; thence in an easterly direction along the line

between the north half and south half of the northeast quarter of section twenty-five, one hundred sixty rods more or less according to Government survey, to the sixteenth post on the east line of section twenty-five; thence in a northerly direction along the east line of section twenty-five eighty rods more or less according to the Government survey, to the place of beginning. The quantity of land embraced in said territory is three hundred twenty acres more or less according to the Government survey. The number of actual residents is two hundred nine and the proposed name of said Village is Waubun. A portion of said territory is platted into lots with a view to Village occupancy.


