


APPOINTMENT OF FREDERICK J. MILLER AS  
SPECIAL ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL TO  
EXAMINE ABSTRACTS OF TITLE FOR THE  
ADJUTANT GENERAL.

I hereby appoint FREDERICK J. MILLER, of Little Falls, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General to examine abstracts of title to lands acquired by the State of Minnesota, through the Adjutant General, for the national guard field training center, known as Camp Ripley, in Morrison County, and to perform such other services in connection therewith as may be required of him.

This appointment is made upon the written request and recommendation of the Adjutant General of the State of Minnesota and upon my judgment that the public welfare will be promoted thereby. The compensation of said appointee is hereby fixed at the rate of Five Dollars for examining and rendering an opinion upon each abstract of 30 entries or less, with an additional fifteen cents per entry for each entry above 30 upon any abstract containing more than 30 entries; provided, that for very short and simple abstracts a reasonable fee of less than Five Dollars shall be charged, subject to the approval of the Attorney General. Such compensation is to be paid out of the funds of the Adjutant General appropriated for the acquisition of the lands aforesaid.
