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PETITION FOR THE INCORPORATION OF THE
VILLAGE OF MANTOVEDI.

TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHINGTON,
IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

We, the undersigned, being twenty-five, or more, of
the voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, and
proposed to be incorporated as a village, and situated in the Town
of Lincoln, in the County of Washington, and State of Minnesota, do
hereby respectfully petition your Honorable Board, and allege:

1. That all of your petitioners are legal voters of
and in the territory hereinafter described, and reside in said ter-
ritory.

2. That the said territory for the incorporation of
which as a village this petition is made, is contained within the
following boundaries:

Beginning at a point on the south
shore of White Bear Lake which point is on the west
line of the East Half of the East Half ($E\frac{1}{2}$ of $E\frac{1}{2}$) of
Section Thirty (30), Township Thirty (30) North, of
Range Twenty-one (21) West; thence, running south
along the West line of said East Half of the East
Half ($E\frac{1}{2}$ of $E\frac{1}{2}$) of Section Thirty (30), to a point
120 feet south of the North line of the Southeast
Quarter of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$), of
said Section Thirty (30); thence east parallel with
the north line of the Southeast Quarter of the South-
east Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty (30) to
the east line of said Section Thirty (30); thence
North 120 feet along the east line of said section
Thirty (30) to the Northeast corner of the South-
east quarter of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$)
of Section Thirty (30); thence East along the North
line of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest
Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-nine (29)
to the Northeast corner of said Southwest Quarter
of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section
Twenty-nine (29); thence North along the West line
of the East Half of the West Half ($E\frac{1}{2}$ of $W\frac{1}{2}$) of
Section Twenty-nine (29) to the East and West cen-
ter line of Section Twenty-nine (29); thence East
along the east and west center line of Section
Twenty-nine (29) to the west right of way line of
the Twin City Lines electric railway; thence
northerly along said west right of way line to the
center line of View Street; thence east along the
center line of View Street to the center line of

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Fairmount Avenue; thence South along the center line of Herritt Street; thence East along the center line of Herritt Street to the center line of Griffin Street; thence North along the center line of Griffin Street to the south right of way line of the Northern Pacific Railway; thence Northwesterly along said south right of way line to the south line of Grove Park; thence West along the South line of Grove Park to the east shore of White Bear Lake; and thence Southerly and Westerly along the shore of White Bear Lake to the point of beginning.

All of said described property being in Lincoln Township, County of Washington, and State of Minnesota, and containing 351.3 acres, more or less, according to the Government survey thereof.

3. That the territory embraced within said boundaries contains 351.3 acres; that of the said 351.3 acres, 274 acres are platted into lots and blocks, the plats of which have been duly and legally certified according to the laws of the State of Minnesota, and have been filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds of the County of Washington, in the State of Minnesota; that the unplatted lands embraced within said territory are adjacent to and adjoin the platted portion, and are so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government; that no part of said territory is embraced in any

1 incorporated village of the State of Minnesota; that hereto attached
2 and made a part hereof, is a map or plat of said territory, marked
3 Exhibit "A" and showing in red thereon the territory above described,
4 and proposed to be incorporated.

5 4. That the territory embraced within the aforesaid
6 boundaries contains a resident population of not more than three
7 thousand inhabitants, nor less than one hundred inhabitants.

8 5. That your petitioners heretofore, to-wit, on and
9 between the second day of April, 1931, and the 29th day of May,
10 1931, caused to be taken a census of the resident population of said
11 territory, and ascertained and determined by the taking of said cen-
12 sus that the said territory contains a resident population of four
13 ^{seventy-six} hundred/(476) inhabitants, which are actual residents within said
14 territory.

15 6. That the name which is proposed to be given to
16 the said territory which is hereby proposed to be incorporated, is
17 the VILLAGE OF MAHTOMEDI.

18 7. That this petition is made for the purpose of
19 having an election held to determine whether or not the said terri-
20 tory shall be incorporated as a village under the name aforesaid.

21 WHEREFORE, Your petitioners pray:

22 1. That your Honorable Board approve said petition,
23 and that it fix a time and place for holding an election within said
24 territory, at which the question of the said proposed incorporation
25 of the said territory as a village shall be submitted and voted upon.

26 2. That it cause notice of said election to be pub-
27 lished and posted according to law, and cause ballots to be prepared,
28 and three inspectors of election to be appointed, who shall act as
29 Judges of said election, and that your Honorable Body take such other
30 steps and proceedings as the law requires, to the end that it may be
31 determined whether or not said territory shall be incorporated.

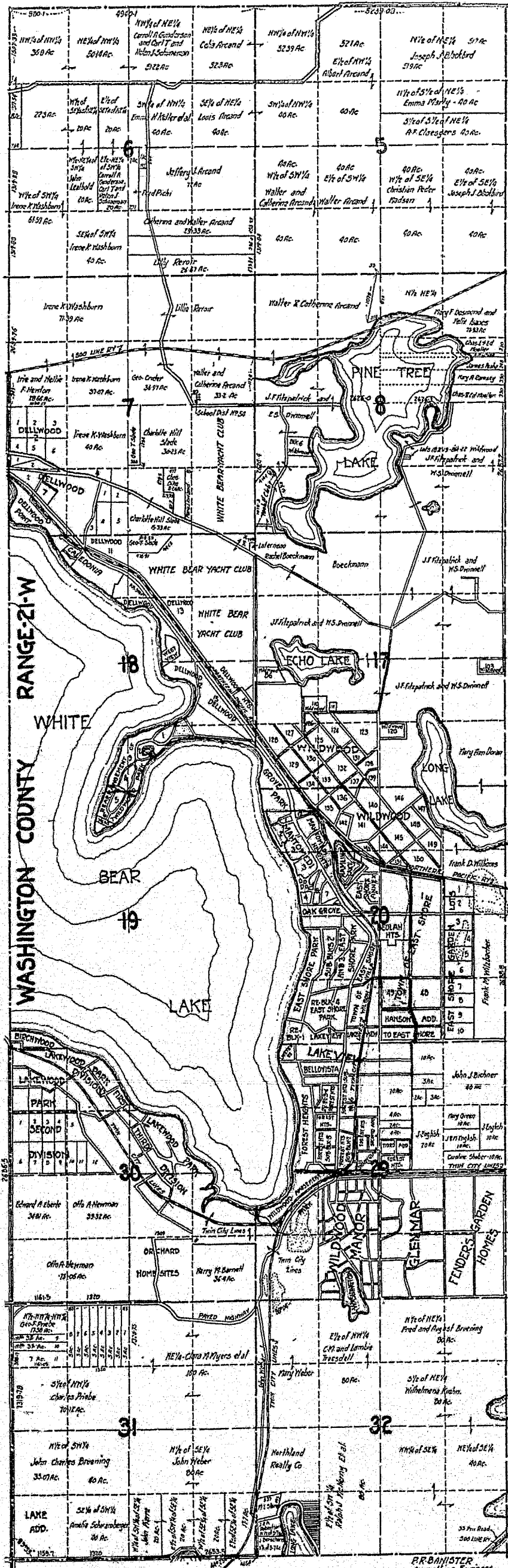




