7 We, the undersigned, being twenty-five, or more, of  
8 the voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, and  
9 proposed to be incorporated as a village, and situated in the Town  
10 of Lincoln, in the County of Washington, and State of Minnesota, do  
11 hereby respectfully petition your Honorable Board, and allege:

12 1. That all of your petitioners are legal voters of  
13 and in the territory hereinafter described, and reside in said ter-  
14 ritory.

15 2. That the said territory for the incorporation of  
16 which as a village this petition is made, is contained within the  
17 following boundaries:

5       4. That the territory embraced within the aforesaid  
6 boundaries contains a resident population of not more than three  
7 thousand inhabitants, nor less than one hundred inhabitants.

8       5. That your petitioners heretofore, to-wit, on and  
9 between the second day of April, 1931, and the 29th day of May,  
10 1931, caused to be taken a census of the resident population of said  
11 territory, and ascertained and determined by the taking of said cen-  
12 sus that the said territory contains a resident population of four  
13 seventy-six  
14 hundred/( 476 ) inhabitants, which are actual residents within said  
territory.

15       6. That the name which is proposed to be given to  
16 the said territory which is hereby proposed to be incorporated, is  
17 the VILLAGE OF MAHTOMEDI.

18       7. That this petition is made for the purpose of  
19 having an election held to determine whether or not the said terri-  
20 tory shall be incorporated as a village under the name aforesaid.

21           WHEREFORE, Your petitioners pray:

22       1. That your Honorable Board approve said petition,  
23 and that it fix a time and place for holding an election within said  
24 territory, at which the question of the said proposed incorporation  
25 of the said territory as a village shall be submitted and voted upon.

26       2. That it cause notice of said election to be pub-  
27 lished and posted according to law, and cause ballots to be prepared,  
28 and three inspectors of election to be appointed, who shall act as  
29 Judges of said election, and that your Honorable Body take such other  
30 steps and proceedings as the law requires, to the end that it may be  
31 determined whether or not said territory shall be incorporated.






